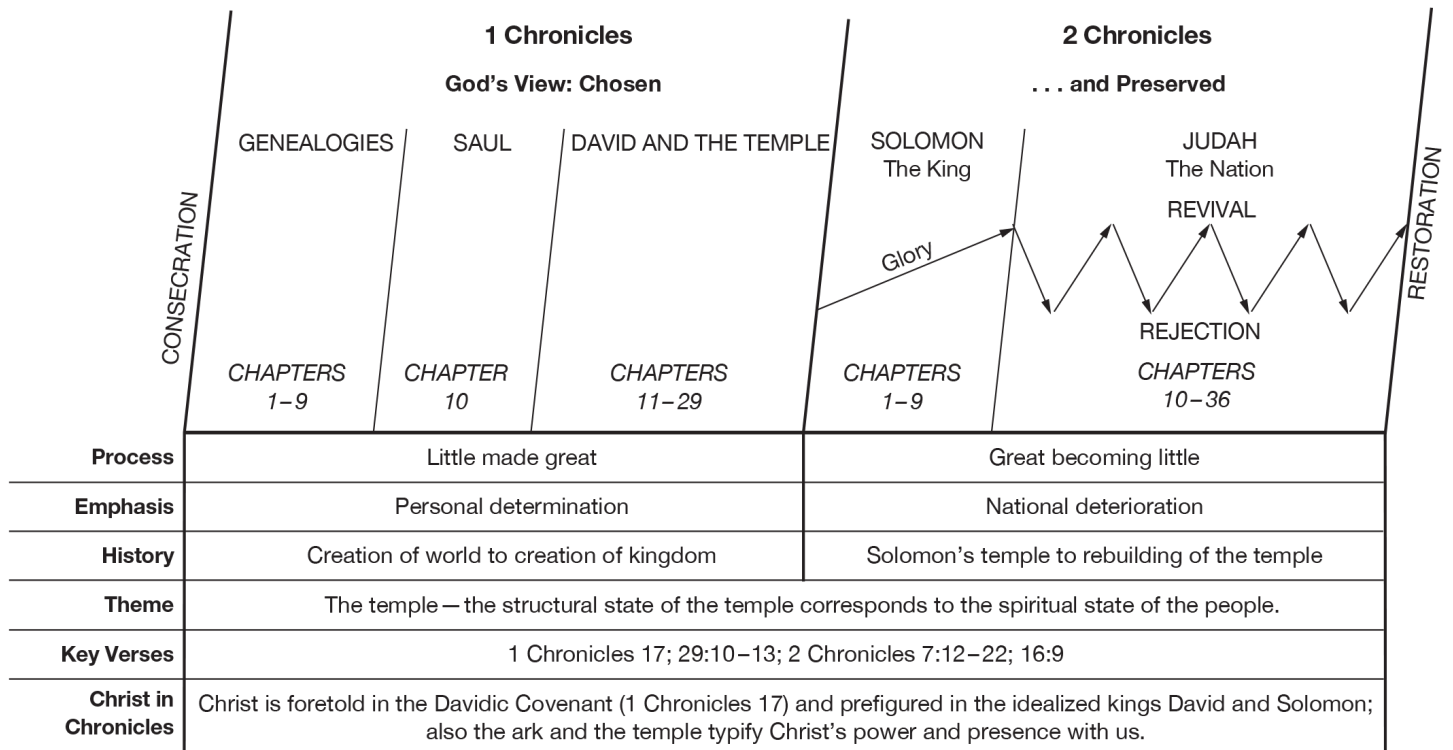


**BIBLE IN A YEAR- Second Chronicles**

**THE BOOK**

1. Kings was to show the accumulating history of **wrongdoing** led to Exile (2 Kings 21:15).
2. The exiles didn't like this explanation; punished for **sins they had not committed** (Jer. 31:29).
3. Chronicler shows that each generation will experience  **blessings**  or  **judgement**  for own actions.
4. Second Chronicles introduces "Theology of **Immediate Retribution**".

**HOW THEOLOGY OF IMMEDIATE RETRIBUTION SHOWN**

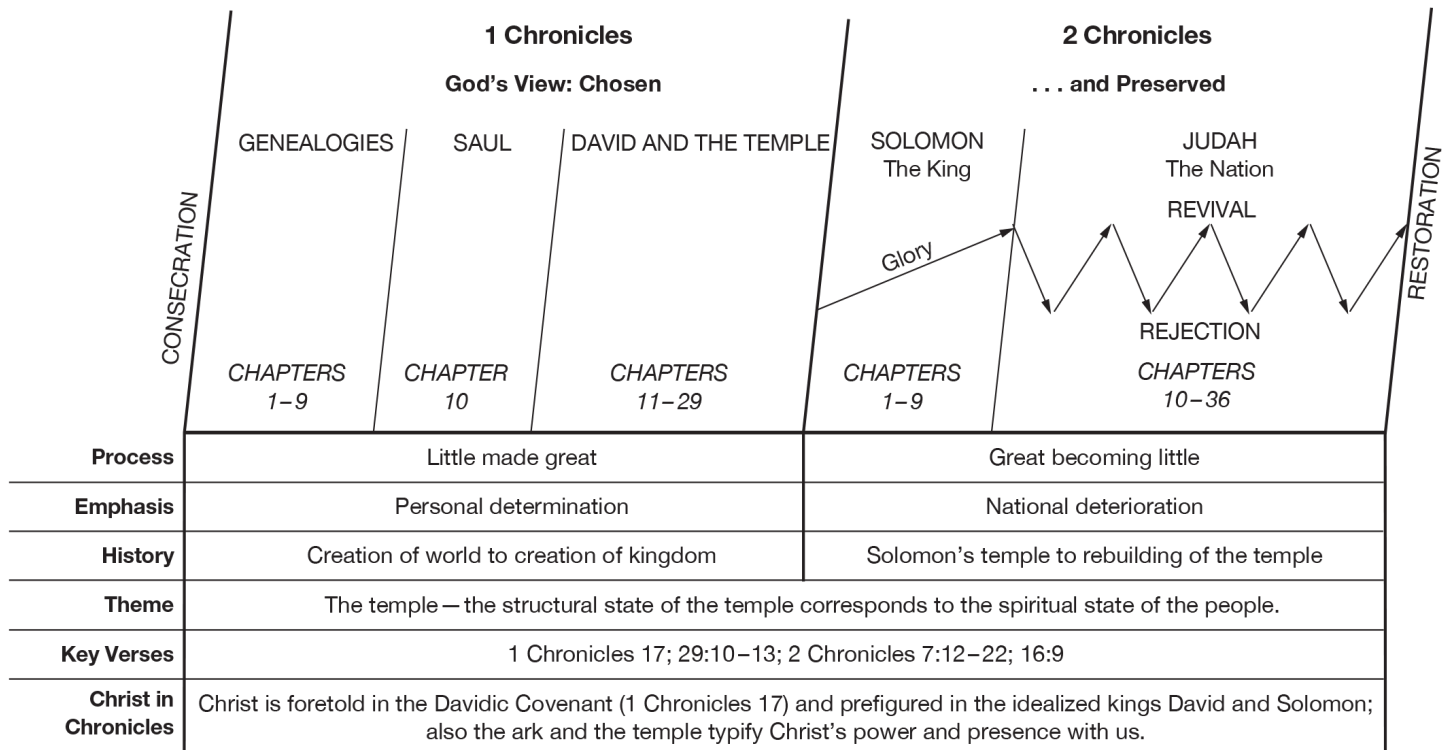
1. Passages **unique** to Chronicles (12:5-8; 15:2; 20:20). Particularly seen in 2 Chron. 7:13-15.
2. Ongoing use of the key aspects of God's requirements: "**seeking God**" (11:16; 12:14; 14:4), "**humbling oneself**" (12:12; 30:11), and "**turning**" (15:4, 30:6, 9; 36:13).
3. Obedience rewarded with **success** (14:7; 26:5); Disobedience brings **defeat** (16:1-9; 21:8-11).
4. Foreign alliances represented failure to **trust God**; always resulted in **judgement** (19:1-3).
5. The wicked kings do not engage **building programs**; have no great **wives**, wealth or armies.
6. Warning people against any **complacency** or presumption of **deferred punishment**.
