### The Author

1. Written to **Jews**, by a **Jew**, about a **Jew**.
2. Matthew was a “**publican**” or Jew who had become a **tax-collector**.
3. Three main objectives of Matthew.
  - a. To demonstrate that Jesus was the **Messiah, King** of the Jews.
  - b. To prove the Jesus did not fail to **establish His kingdom**.
  - c. To confirm the legitimacy of the **Gentile mission**.
