### **Volunteer Worker Training**

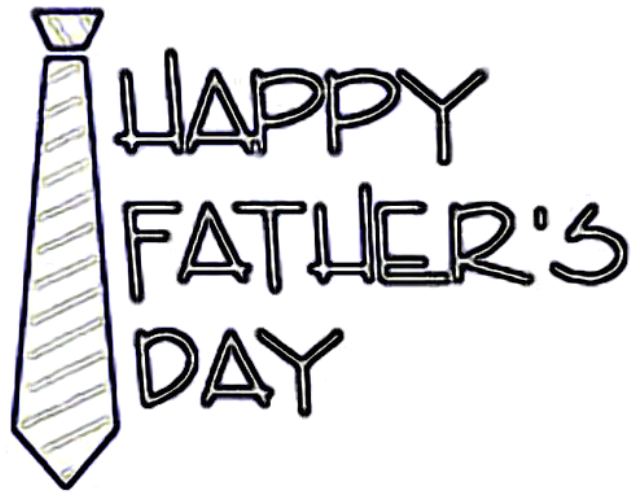

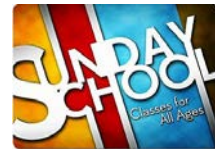
### Vacation Bible School – GodSquad: Special Agents in Action
