# The Center and Context of Paul's Theology

Center: God's graciousness toward His weak and sinful creatures (I Cor. 15:9-10)

**Context:** The "<u>Powerful</u>" and the "<u>Powerless</u>" ("Strong" and "Weak"). The powerful either impose unnecessary <u>burden</u> or withhold a necessary <u>blessing</u>. The powerless either <u>accept</u> unnecessary burden or <u>employ</u> ungodly methods to obtain blessing.

- 1. Imposition of the Jewish law on Gentile believers in Galatia (Gal. 1: 6; 5: 6)
- 2. A divisive elitism in Corinth that arose in native church culture (1 Cor. 1: 26–31)
- 3. Lagging of contribution to collection for the poor in Jerusalem (2 Cor. 8: 1, 6–7)
- 4. Timothy's need for encouragement not to be ashamed of the gospel (2 Tim. 1: 8–9).

## The Content of Paul's Theology

Revelation of the Righteousness of God (Rom. 1:16-17).

- 1. God's righteousness is not present in humans because of <u>our sin</u> (Rom. 1-3)
- 2. God's righteousness is **imputed** unto us when God justifies by faith (Rom 4-5)
- 3. God's righteousness is <u>demonstrated</u> as we go from "devils" to disciples (Rom. 6-8)
- 4. God's righteousness is to be applied in **<u>practical ways</u>** throughout life (Rom. 12-16)
