Prayer Meeting – Saturday

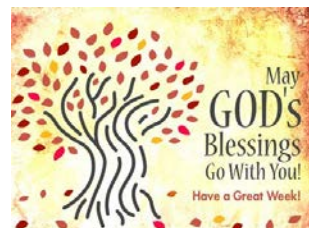
